Animal communication

Woody is a challenging dog, he fights with the others, chews the house to bits, and if he were ever to do what I asked of him I don't think I could cope with the shock. However, the pack was in turmoil at the time, Woody was becoming increasingly aggressive with the other dogs. The day before he had attacked one of my elderly dogs, sending more chaotic ripples through the already fragile relationships of our pack. I would have tried anything to repair our family and Laura's offer came at the right time. We all needed help.

Laura's evaluation of Woody was pretty much a miracle, and has turned a sceptic into a believer. During the session Laura was able to reach Woody at a level that we could not. She described how he had a problem with his eating (which was 100% true), how his aggression was really frustration at how he felt alienated from the rest of the pack, and that he didn't feel as if I listened to him anymore. I know these things to be true, after all that we had been through I have to admit to having almost given up on him at times. Thinking that he just didn't want to be part of our family anymore, and that he would be better off and happier with another family. Laura was able to let me see it all from Woody's perspective, and how I could help him feel part of the family again. So now I can do what any dog owner would do, help the member of my family that is in need. Without Laura's help I wouldn't have known what else I could do. We are still a work in progress, but all families have to have a place to start. Thanks to Laura I have found my starting point.
